ANACS SUBMISSION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

ANACS renders an opinion on a coin's authenticity and grade, ANACS provides many additional services to submitters; some of these services include verifying or researching requested attributions, varieties and errors; authenticating and grading "problem coins"; authenticating and grading world coins.

ANACS reserves the right to correct submission form to reflect current fees. Fees are non-refundable; even should the coin(s) be determined ineligible for encapsulation for any reason.

ANACS GUARANTEE COIN(S) 1/2/2008

Coin grading is a subjective science and always reflects the expert opinion of ANACS' graders, who have certified millions of coins since ANACS was established in 1972. ANACS guarantees the grade and authenticity of coins it has certified and encapsulated in an ANACS holder since being purchased by new ownership on January 1, 2008. Furthermore, ANACS guarantees that every coin submitted to it shall be certified by ANACS' grading experts in strict accordance with the ANACS grading standards, policies and procedures.

In the event the owner of an ANACS-graded coin believes there has been an error in the grading, the owner may resubmit the coin to ANACS for re-examination. If the re-examination grade is lower than the grade originally assigned by ANACS, ANACS agrees, at its discretion, to either purchase the coin from the owner at fair market value or pay the owner of the coin the difference between the coin's fair market value at the re-examination grade and the fair market value at the grade originally assigned by ANACS. ANACS will be the sole determiner for the current fair market value of the coin based on what ANACS believes is reliable current market information. ANACS' determination of fair market value shall be binding on all parties.

This Guarantee applies only to ANACS-certified platinum, gold and silver coins and excludes bronze, copper and copper-nickel coins as these are delicate materials, easily affected by environmental conditions. This Guarantee does not apply to the following: any coin in a damaged, unsealed, counterfeit or altered ANACS holder; any clerical error(s) as to the description or grade of the coin; any "problem coins" that carry a "detail" and / or a "net" grade; any coin subjected to improper storage conditions such as extreme heat or cold, humidity, moisture, sunlight, etc.; and any coins removed from the ANACS holder. This Guarantee takes the place and supersedes all other or previous guarantees, warranties, either expressed or implied.

ANACS' expertise is unmatched by any other grading service in regards varieties and attributions. However, attribution specialists and experts may sometimes disagree concerning any given variety or attributions. Also, some varieties are de-listed each year and others have their variety numbers and / or descriptions changed or modified. As a result, ANACS cannot guarantee any attribution or variety designation listed on an ANACS holder. If an ANACS customer has an ANACS-encapsulated coin that has had its variety or attribution listing changed or modified, the customer may, for a nominal fee, return the coin to ANACS so it can be updated.

Coins that were certified by ANACS under previous ownership will be reholdered in ANACS' blue label. Coins that were certified since January 1, 2008, when ANACS began its new ownership, will be reholdered using ANACS' gold label.

Important: Verbal opinions given by ANACS Graders at shows are estimates only. Coins must be submitted to ANACS for official determination of authenticity or grade. Verbal opinions are in no way guaranteed intended to be helpful guidelines and are in no way guaranteed.

At ANACS, any coin that we believe may be counterfeit or altered may be returned to the customer with a note calling the piece "Questionable Authenticity." This would mean we are not absolutely certain the coin is a counterfeit, but we believe it may be.

If we are absolutely certain the coin is indeed a counterfeit or an alteration, pursuant to federal law and in accordance with our legal obligations we reserve the right to turn the piece over to the U.S Secret Service. The Secret Service's standard procedure is to contact the current owner and the previous owner and have the previous owner return the purchase price to the buyer. The Secret Service's ultimate goal is to trace the coin back to the original perpetrator.

ANACS AUTHENTICATES AND GRADES:

- Foreign Planchets.
- Paper money.
- Non-genuine coins.
- Coins with active PVC or active corrosion.
- Holed Coins.
- Coins less than 11mm in diameter.
- Coins exceeding 40mm in diameter or 3.8mm in thickness.
- Casino Chips

VARIETY, ATTRIBUTION & ERROR VERIFICATION RESEARCH:

- Verification. ANACS will verify and designate attributions supplied by you (the submitter) for an additional \$5 per coin. This includes varieties, reference attribution and errors. **Specific variety or die numbers must be listed by you** (i.e. FS-25-1969D-501, VAM 17A, rpm double die, etc.) in the variety column of the submission form. **Turnaround time for verification may take up to an additional 15 business days.**
- Attribution Research. ANACS will do all the research for you and attribute coins submitted for grading and encapsulation for an additional \$10 per coin. This includes varieties, reference attribution and errors. Be sure to write "attribute" in the variety column for the coin(s) you want ANACS to attribute. **Turnaround time for attribution research may take up to an additional 15 business days.**

CROSSOVER SUBMISSION POLICIES/PROCEDURES: (Coins in other grading service's holders)

Coins for Crossover are inspected in the other grading services' holder with the grade covered. When ANACS' first grades are determined, these grades are compared against the minimum grade you listed on the submission form. If the minimum grade that you listed on the submission form is met or exceeded, the coin is removed from its sealed holder and encapsulated in an ANACS holder. You will be charged the full grading fee regardless of whether the coin crosses over or not.

CROSSOVER GRADE DISCLAIMER:

By signing this form, submitter authorizes ANACS to crossover the listed coins for ANACS encapsulation at or above the listed minimum grade, and to remove qualifying coins from the sealed holders in which they are submitted. Submitter further agrees to release ANACS from its crossover grade if, when removed from the holder, a coin exhibits detracting factors which are not visible through the plastic. In that instance, ANACS is not bound to honor the crossover final grade; however when that happens, all submission fees for that coin will be refunded to the submitter. ANACS reserves the right to crack open holders with no minimum grade listed.

- Indicate on your shipping label or on the outside of your package the speed of service requested.
- Do **not** submit coins in flips that have staples. ANACS is not responsible for any damage to a coin that is submitted with a staple. Also do not use flips that are old, damaged or contain PVC or other residues.
- Once your order has been returned, limit the possibility of environmental damage to your coins by securing them in a climate controlled, low humidity storage. No third party grading service has a 100% air tight holder, including ANACS. Because of this toning (a natural process of oxidation) may continue to occur after encapsulation.

To calculate return shipping, *add postage and insurance coverage* based on number of coins and owner's value.
